How to get there!

From Mission, take Lougheed Highway, #7 west. Immediately past Stave River turn right on 287th Street, which becomes Wilson Road. At Dewdney Trunk Road turn right and travel 'til just before the Stave Falls Dam where you turn right, into the Hayward Lake Recreation Area.

Meet in the parking lot.

How to get there!

Head north on Glover Road through the village. Fort Camping is on your left after you cross the bridge. Meet in the parking lot.
